

Waiver of Liability for COVID-19

Therefore, if you choose to utilize NCBM's services and/or enter onto the mobile units, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19. I hereby choose to accept the risk of contracting COVID-19 for myself in order to utilize NCBM's services and enter NCBM's premises. These services are of such value to me that I accept the risk of being exposed to, contracting, and/or spreading COVID-19 in order to utilize NCBM's services and premises.

WAIVER OF LAWSUIT/LIABILITY: I hereby forever release and waive my right to bring suit against NCBM and its owners, officers, directors, managers, officials, trustees, agents, employees, or other representatives in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of COVID-19 related to utilizing NCBM's services and premises. I understand that this waiver means I give up my right to bring any claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any claim I may have to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen.

COVID-19 Daily Screening Procedure

- Please use hand sanitizer each time you enter or depart the Rebuild Center or Mission Camp.
- Temperature checks will be performed at the start of each work day. These are done individually by you, upon arrival to the Rebuild Center or Mission Camp. Please record your information on your checklist each day of work in your individual file. Wipe down the thermometer handle after you have completed your temperature check.
- Complete the COVID checklist each day of work and record results in your individual file. Please use individual pens or ensure pens are disinfected after each use.
- Wear a face covering if you are in shared/communal areas
- Practice social distancing of at least 6 feet from others at all times
- Don't shake hands, touch, or hug others

Questions on the COVID-19 Checklist:

- Have you or anyone in your household had any of the following symptoms in the last 21 days: sore throat, cough, chills, body aches for unknown reasons, shortness of breath, headache for unknown reasons, diarrhea, vomiting, loss of smell, loss of taste, fever at or greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit?
- To the best of your knowledge have you been in close proximity to any individual who tested positive for COVID-19?
- If you answer YES to any question on the Daily Screening Log, please notify your site coordinator and return home.
